Pragelato is a mountain resort town in the Piedmont region in the upper Val Chisone, in the heart of the Cottian Alps at an altitude of 1,535 m. amidst peaks that reach up to 3,280 m. The town boasts a rich history: from the barbarian invasions to the Republic of the Escartons, from the Duchy of Savoy to today's Italian Republic. This mountain town with 19 distinctive hamlets bears the tangible remnants of past civilizations which have left their mark and cultural heritage not only on the customs and traditions of the local population, but also with drawings, dates and symbols on sundials, ancient fountains and ovens.



Pragelato was a competition site when Turin hosted the XX Olympic Winter Games in 2006, and the 2007 Turin Universiade for cross-country skiing, ski jumping and Nordic combined events. The location has long been known for off-piste skiing and the connection to the Via Lattea via cable car for downhill skiing. The Olympic runs and the cross-country skiing tourist trails are ideal for both beginners and more experienced cross-country skiers along the wonderful tracks immersed in the evocative landscapes of the Val Troncea Park. Pragelato is the capital of cross-country skiing.



The summer potential of Pragelato is not to be underestimated, for both classic and modern activities: hiking, mountain biking, Nordic walking, horse riding, golf and dog trekking are some of the activities that can be practiced in this natural environment with its breathtaking views.



The day cannot be concluded without delicious local gastronomic specialties, made with simple and typical mountain ingredients such as potatoes, mountain cheeses, wildflower honey and alpine herbs that provide a memorable experience for the palate.

With its ancient history and a modern approach to offer tourists, Pragelato's identity continues in an era that has irremediably changed. The countdown for the 2025 University World Games in Turin has officially started; meanwhile the whole community of Pragelato is happy to welcome and host the 2022 OPA Cup and Games in this wonderful setting.

ITINERARY



By CAR from Turin: A32 motorway (Turin-Bardonecchia) to Oulx (80 km); then exit and go up to Sestriere (20 km), then SP 23 in the direction of Pinerolo up to Pragelato (14 km).

By CAR from Turin: SP 23 from the Pinerolo exit of the tang. of Turin in the direction of Sestriere up to Pragelato (90 km).

By CAR from France: Frejus tunnel, then A32 to the Oulx exit (18 km); then exit and go up to Sestriere (20 km), then SP 23 in the direction of Pinerolo up to Pragelato (14 km). Or: Colle del Monginevro, then Claviere, SP23 for Cesana Torinese, Sestriere and then in the direction of Pinerolo-Turin up to Pragelato (14 km).




